CONFIDENTIALITY STATEMENT

Women's Health Hope is committed to being a positive influence in women's lives, growing a support network that is inclusive of people from all kinds of backgrounds. We believe that all people have the right to be heard and treated with respect.

We will never use an individual's personal information in any way that disregards their rights stated in the GDPR. All personal information is stored correctly and only those employed may seek access should they need to.

Anything that is spoken about within group sessions is confidential and we ask that every person involved within our group respects this requirement.

In some instances we may have to raise any concerns we may have for an individual's welfare - for example, if somebody discloses that they are in an abusive relationship or are in a mental health crisis we may have to escalate/signpost this to the relevant team that may be able to assist.

We want our voices to be heard, we will always ask permission to use your voices to make positive changes in women's health, and we will ask any individual to sign a consent form for us to gain permission to use these statements.

This includes joining us on podcasts and marketing to allow our group to gain further traction.

Womens Health Hope wants to make a change - we want to allow women to have an open discussion about their concerns. If we can use our service to improve the treatment that we receive in the healthcare sector and to stop healthcare inequality for women we would hope our children, grandchildren and all future generations will finally get their voices heard about their women's health concerns and conditions.
